Oregon State is the state's Land Grant university and is one of only two universities in the U.S. to have Sea Grant, Space Grant and Sun Grant designations as well. Oregon State welcomes applications from students who demonstrate preparedness for our academic programs.

Oregon State's admission requirements promote student success by assessing student preparedness and academic potential in the unique context of each student's personal experience. Admission assessment will consider all achievements, both academic and non-academic, to enroll students with a broad range of characteristics and perspectives. These charts indicate the SAT and ACT score ranges and grade-point averages for the middle 50% of high school students admitted to Oregon State for fall 2018. We conduct a holistic review of each student's application that takes into consideration many more factors than test scores and cumulative grade-point average.

Please note that academic performance is not the sole criterion for admission to the university. The university may evaluate a person's behavior and background to determine their ability to maintain the standards of academic and professional conduct expected at the university. An evaluation may take into consideration current behavior and performance as well as past experiences and actions. Simply qualifying for admission does not guarantee admission.
